### What is it about?

### Who is it for?

### How is it delivered?

These courses are delivered using flexible distance learning methods with optional workshops when required. This reflects the needs of our students and their employers and makes it attractive to international students.

### To apply

The programme has flexible entry and exit requirements to allow you to enter at a level appropriate to your education and experience.

You must hold:

- A relevant degree and/or a relevant professional qualification and/or the ability to demonstrate an ability to study at post graduate level.
- Interview and additional written submission may be required.

Recognition of prior learning is available for up to 50% of the award for which you are applying.
