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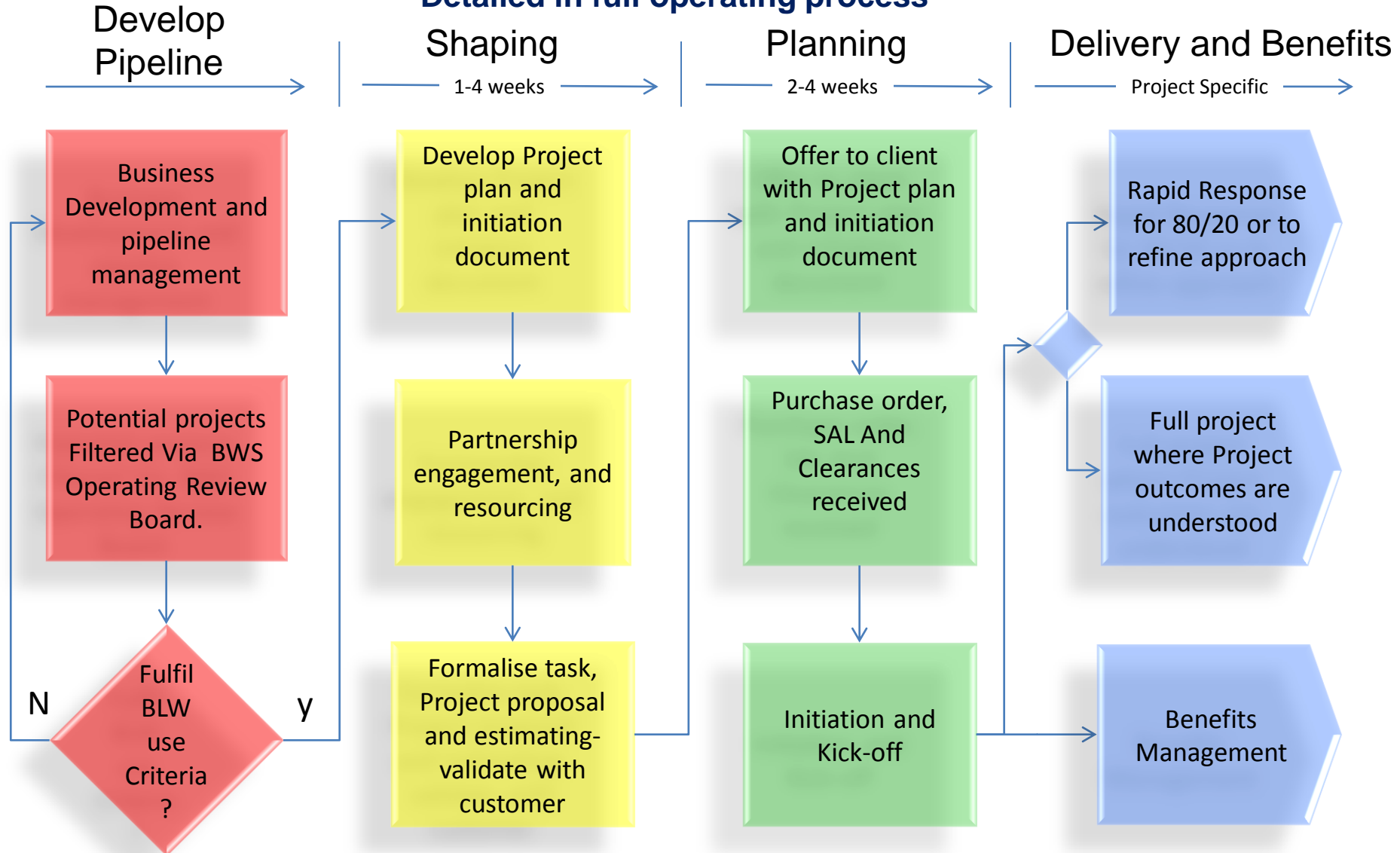

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■ Tactical

- Tactical decision making
- Reduce risk and support better procurement, business change and risk reduction,
- Benefits are accrued to the specific project
- E.g.. Support to investment fund, output based specifications, capability demonstrators, feasibilities and options

■ Operational

- Operational performance and optimisation
- Outcomes and strategies, policy and procedure where benefits may be re-used to gain better value
- E.g.. Optimisation approaches, strategic options, interoperability, enterprise planning
